Youth Code of Conduct

As a club we will:

- encourage every player in the club to reach their full potential
- place the well-being and safety of the young people above the development of performance
- make sure every player is signed in/out of every training session
- ensure all lead coaches are qualified and coaches and volunteers are DBS checked
- ensure that activities are appropriate for the age and ability level of the group being coached
- promote fair play and teach the rules of etiquette and skills required for cricket
- encourage players to value their performance not just the result
- make the training and matches as much fun as possible
- respect the young people's decisions about their participation
- display high standards of language, manner, punctuality, preparation, presentation, behaviour and appearance
- work within the ECB guidelines Welfare of Young People (safe hands) policy and procedure
- have insurance cover
- report any welfare concerns to the welfare officer

As parents/carers we will

- ensure that our child adheres to training evening registration procedures
- encourage our child to learn the rules and play within them
- help the players to recognise good performance not just results
- never force our child to participate
- always set a good example with our conduct at training and matches
- support the decisions made by officials, coaches and captains
- support our child's involvement and help them to enjoy their cricket
- use correct and appropriate language at all times
- encourage our child to accept responsibility for their own performance and behaviour
- pay the subscription fee promptly at the start of the season
- ensure that our child is on time for all training sessions and matches
- make contact with the coach if we are unable to attend a match
- inform the club of any change in contact details

As players we will:

- play within the rules and respect the officials' decisions
- behave safely and sensibly in both practices and games
- use appropriate language towards coaches and fellow players
- be on time for all games and training sessions
- follow training evening registration procedures
- pay match fees on the day of the match
- support our fellow team mates in an appropriate manner
- respect all other members of the club and any other players, coaches or officials that we meet through Charlbury Cricket Club
- wear appropriate kit (whites/tracksuit bottoms/shorts collared t-shirts) and footwear (trainers or spikes) to every training session and match
- wear our hair tied back to ensure that we are playing safely
- not wear jewellery

Please note that in applying for membership, you consent to the named children participating in Charlbury Youth Cricket activities. You are giving permission for the administration of emergency first aid and/or other medical treatment in an emergency, and understand all reasonable steps will be taken to make contact with you.
